

The Tuesday Fun Doubles bowling league is exactly what is says on the tin. It is a doubles bowling league that bowls on a Tuesday evening with the emphasis on fun.

The league is a BTBA sanctioned league, so we bowl under national guidelines, with our own constitution. The league started some 17-18 years ago and has gradually grown in strength and popularity. As the name suggests we are a league of teams with 2 bowlers representing each team. A team could comprise of up to 4 bowlers, any 2 of which play each week. All bowlers have to be members of the BTBA. Bowler can join the BTBA through any sanctioned league though most of the Tuesday Fun Doubles bowlers join through the Tuesday league.

Currently we are 18 teams and we bowl twice round in a season. So each team bowls 34 games. The season starts in September and continues through to the following June, with breaks for Xmas, New Year, Easter and the school half terms.

Roll off is 7.30pm, though this time may vary season to season depending upon members wishes and agreement with Guildford Spectrum. Being a sanctioned league we have a contract with Spectrum to bowl. Spectrum agrees to provide the lanes to the appropriate standard and we as a league agree to bowl each week. So bowlers have to be committed for the complete season, not just turn up as and when it suits them.

Current lineage is £12 per bowler per team. This includes the Spectrum lineage as well as contributions to the prize fund, administration fees and a reserve fund. The latter tends to cover BTBA fees for the following season.
